Subject: Online capacity building programme on SAGY-II (2019-24) for Charge Officers and other stakeholders


Madam/Sir,

The Guidelines of Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) call upon the Hon'ble Members of Parliament to develop five model Gram Panchayats in their respective constituencies during 2019-24 (one per year). Accordingly, the Hon'ble Members of Rajya Sabha and 17th Lok Sabha have already identified nearly 856 Gram Panchayats for development under SAGY during 2019-24 and more are being identified. It is therefore, imperative that capacity building on the programme of these newly appointed Charge Officers of Gram Panchayats and other stakeholders be carried out.
