Please refer to your D.O.No. M-13012/3/2014-SAGY dated 25th November, 2014 seeking Action Taken Report on the implementation of the approval of the Cabinet on Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY).

2. Department while conveying its concurrence to the proposal, requested for incorporating its concerns. As Broadband Telecom connectivity is also be an eligible activity for provision of basic amenities in the village, it was conveyed that National Optical Fibre Network (NOFN) would lay incremental fibre to provide broadband connectivity to each of the 2,50,000 Gram Panchayats in the country. The project to provide connectivity in all 2.50,000 Gram Panchayats is likely to be completed by Dec, 2016. It does not envisage connectivity to villages other than those where the Headquarters of the Gram Panchayat is located. Accordingly, it was suggested to identify such villages for implementation of broadband connectivity in Gram Panchayat Headquarters to dovetail NOFN with the SAGY. It was also communicated that in case other villages are chosen, then DoT would not be in a position to ensure broadband connectivity with village under its present scheme. I request you to kindly incorporate this while issuing the guidelines for implementation of SAGY.

3. I assure you that the Department of Telecommunications will make all efforts to provide connectivity to those Gram Panchayats which are selected under the SAGY on priority.
