Dear Shri Goyal,

Please refer to your DO # M-13012/3/2014-SAGY dated 3rd November 2014 regarding changes in the guidelines of Central Sector and Centrally Sponsored Schemes to enable priority to be given to the Gram Panchayats under Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana(SAGY).

2. The Ministry of Food Processing Industries is implementing Schemes for giving impetus to the development of food processing sector. Both the Central Sector and Centrally Sponsored Schemes of this Ministry are project oriented.


3. Further, the provisions for monitoring in the guidelines of this Ministry's Centrally Sponsored Scheme namely, 'National Mission on Food Processing' (NMFP) are as under:-

- (i) At the Central Government Level, a National Food Processing Development Council (NFPDC) under the chairmanship of Minister of Food Processing Industries.
- (ii) At the State/UT Government level, State Food Processing Development Council (SFPDC) under the chairmanship of the Chief Secretary having representatives from other concerned Departments.

Thus, according to priority to a Gram Panchayat selected under SAGY for implementation of NMFP falls in the domain of the State / UT Governments. These SAGY guidelines are being sent to the State/ UT Governments for appropriate action.
