

I. Best Performing District Collector/ CEO (Zilla Parishad) :

As per the SAGY Guidelines, the District Collector is the nodal officer for implementing SAGY. However, in some States like Karnataka, the CEO,Zilla Parishad is acting as District Nodal Officer for SAGY. Accordingly, the award may be given to a District Collector or CEO(wherever it's applicable) who acted as District Nodal Officer for SAGY GPs.

Eligibility Criteria for DM/DC/CEO

1. DM/DC/CEO should have been functioned as District Nodal Officer,SAGY-II GPs at least for 6 Months
2. All GPs selected in previous years should have prepared VDP.
3. All GPs should have Charge Officer appointed
4. SAGY GPs should have completed environment creation activities, baseline survey and situation analysis for all selected GPs for the year of consideration.
5. GPs of that district which have prepared VDP should have completed at least 40% of VDP projects.
6. DLC meeting should have been conducted at least once in two months.
7. If there are more than 1 SAGY GPs in the District, the average weightage will be taken.

Nominations are to be entered online in the dedicated form to be published on the SAGY website. The following fields are to be entered.

- a. Name of the District Collector/CEO
- b. Name of State, District and GP
- c. Contact details of the SAGY GP and the concerned District administration
- d. Name of the person entering the details

The following criteria are proposed for scoring the best performing District Collector/CEO.

On the basis of these the Award Cell will give scores and do ranking for the award.

II. Best Performing SAGY Charge Officer :

As per the SAGY Guidelines, the District Collector will appoint a competent Charge Officer of sufficient seniority, for every Gram Panchayat who will coordinate the implementation at the local level and will be fully responsible and accountable for the implementation

Eligibility criteria

1. Functioned as Charge Officer for at least 6 months during the year of consideration.
2. Details of CO should have been entered in SAGY MIS
3. VDP of his/her GP should be uploaded
4. CO should have undergone training(maybe online also) by NIRD/MoRD
5. GP should have completed at least 50% of VDP projects
6. The Charge Officer should have coordinated a minimum of 4 meetings at the Panchayat Samiti level in 6 months and a minimum of 2 meetings at the District level

Nominations are to be entered online in the dedicated form to be published on the SAGY website. The following details are to be entered.

- a. Name and Designation of the Charge Officer
- b. Name of the GP, District, State
- c. Contact details of the SAGY GP and the concerned District administration
- d. Brief description of challenges faced by the Charge Officer
- e. Name and Designation of the person entering the details

The following criteria and weightages are proposed for scoring the best performing Charge Officer. On the basis of these the committee will give scores and do ranking for the award.

4. Best Practices in implementing SAGY GPs

- The proposed practices/initiative should be easily replicable and can inspire other SAGY Gram Panchayats to learn and adopt
- It should be affordable and sustainable in the rural areas of India.
- It should be reproducible in a short period of time(in 6 months)
- The initiative should have been implemented on the ground and should have created a positive impact on the villagers of SAGY GPs

Nominations are to be entered online in the dedicated form to be published on the SAGY website. The following fields are to be entered.

- Name of State, District and GP
- Title of the good practices/intervention
- The best practices should be from one of the 8 Sectors mentioned in the SAGY Guidelines
- Sponsoring organisation if any
- Objective of the practices
- Give a brief description of the practices
- Photographs

An Expert Committee will be formed to examine the nominated practices/initiatives. The selected practices will be documented and disseminated by MoRD.
